GRANT

\$10,000 was awarded to the Habitat for Humanity of Greater Lowell to go towards the renovation portion of their Neighborhood Revitalization Initiative (NRI). In late April 2016, a new NRI program was started in the Centralville neighborhood of Lowell. The purpose of the grant was to provide the opportunity of homeownership to low income families, and provide needy seniors and veterans critical home repairs to safely remain in their homes.

IMPACT

This grant allowed them to transform a toxic house with lead paint, asbestos and rotten/moldy wood into a decent, safe and healthy home for a deserving low income family.
