

# #MakeAVaccinePlan: Individuals

Here is how you can prepare to get your COVID-19 vaccine when it's available to you.



- **Find out when you are eligible for your vaccine**, based on your age, health status, or occupation, at Mass DPH ([mass.gov/info-details/massachusetts-covid-19-vaccination-phases](https://mass.gov/info-details/massachusetts-covid-19-vaccination-phases)).
- **Talk to your employer** to see if your workplace has resources or expectations about COVID-19 vaccination.
- **Prepare any documentation** you may need when it's your turn to get the vaccine, like an ID card, or document proving your employment eligibility.
- **Coordinate with other members of your household** to make a household vaccine plan. For example, find out if members of your household can get their shots on the same day to share a ride.
- **Choose on a secure place to store your vaccination card** and remind yourself of your second appointment, if necessary.
